

The Lasallian S.P.O.O.N **(Support Program and Opportunity for Oneness through Nourishment)**

The Lasallian Support Program and Opportunity for Oneness through Nourishment (S.P.O.O.N.) is established to embody the Lasallian values of unity, service, and care by providing nourishment as an essential support for deserving scholars to succeed in their academic and personal endeavors.

Through Lasallian S.P.O.O.N., the university extends an invitation to journey alongside these students, providing them with essential nourishment as an allied initiative to the University's scholarship program. The program offers more than a daily meal—it embodies a Lasallian educational opportunity that nurtures both the mind and body, creating a foundation for a nourished soul.

By inviting partners and the campus community to contribute, we can create a supportive environment that allows every student the opportunity to succeed.

Objectives

- Provide daily meals to scholars, ensuring they have the nourishment needed for health and focus.
- Involve concessionaires and sponsors in supporting scholars through meal partnerships.
- Foster compassion and unity by supporting students' basic needs.
- Help scholars concentrate on their studies by reducing food insecurity on campus.

Mechanics

- Scholars are chosen each semester from the list of recipients under the Student Financial Aid Grant, including those endorsed by partner organizations such as student athletes and POLCA. New scholars are selected each term to expand opportunities.
- Scholars receive one meal per day worth Php 100 from participating concessionaires during operating hours. Meals must be availed on the same day and cannot be carried over to another day.
- NO CASH will be given to a qualified scholar-beneficiary
- Concessionaires will be provided with an availment form, where scholars will sign and specify the type of meal they are availing. This form will serve as documentation and facilitate accurate tracking.
- Monthly reports will be generated to monitor program utilization and evaluate its impact.
- The program operates each semester, with continuity based on available resources and eligibility.
- Continued funding and support will be sought from concessionaires and sponsors to sustain and expand the program.
- As a symbol of gratitude, sponsors will receive the "SEAL OF GENEROSITY " to display in their establishments, signifying their generosity and support for the Lasallian S.P.O.O.N.
